

**MESSAGE 48      JUNE.2.2018**

He is coming, the Lord is coming: doors open the lintels because the King of Glory<sup>1</sup> will pass.

I will lift the locks; I will open the doors of your hearts, because I come to judge the world of its injustice, of cruelty, of the evil that ravages this Earth.

Fear not, son of Zion<sup>2</sup>, do not fear little worm<sup>3</sup> of Israel, do not fear My people, for your King and your Redeemer come to do justice to a lost world, doomed to eternal death, nothing will be left without My justice.

There will be no mercy for those who did evil to My chosen ones, to my little ones of the soul, only eternal condemnation will be their payment, because you, son, who lives in this world of sin, suffered and cried for My love and because of My Name suffered<sup>4</sup> the greatest insults and slander, calamities and reproach and all of you who stood up<sup>5</sup> for the Son of man, you will see your glory beside Me when My angels gather My children<sup>6</sup>, My sheep, from all corners of the world. There will be no mercy for those who did you wrong, My people, but your glory will be at My side for an eternity.

Do not be scared of the evil that I am going to send to this world of sin and perdition, My people lie down, prey of the infernal enemy that infers one pain after another; but be calm, people of My entrails, because your Savior is at your side. They will come from the east and from the west and bow to Me, their King and Savior and they will recognize My Glory and My Power<sup>8</sup> when I save them from the clutches of the infernal enemy and see Me come down among the clouds<sup>9</sup> with My angels, because you saw Me full of reproach and died on the Cross and did not believe in the power of your God, you only saw My humiliation, but behold, now I come covered with Glory and Majesty<sup>10</sup> and you will prostrate before Me your God and Lord.

O children who doubt before your Savior because you see him mocked, killed on a Cross<sup>11</sup>, humiliated, Man of sorrows<sup>12</sup> and did not see My Glory and My Power<sup>13</sup> your heart was dull with the pride of the world and you did not see your Redeemer dressed in humility and poverty, simplicity and meekness. What is happening in your hearts, children, who only want and seek the glory of this world and do not see the Glory of Heaven that becomes one of so many<sup>14</sup>, less than in sin<sup>15</sup>?

O children of men, how dull you have your heart that you do not see the Glory and the Majesty in the humiliation of the Cross, in the reproach and the slander of sin attacking your Redeemer. You saw Him nailed to the Cross dripping His Blood from His wounds and you confused Him with a thief, with a murderer, with a blasphemer<sup>16</sup>; you did not see His greatness, His Glory, His suffering and sorrowful heart, pierced by your crimes and sins<sup>17</sup>, the tears of His Mother at the foot of His Cross<sup>18</sup>; you did not see the Majesty of God<sup>19</sup> who covered himself with pain and blood, tears and

pain; you only see the cheap and substitute glory of this world that does not shine beyond your eyes, hurt by the blindness of sin. You did not see your dead Redeemer, dying on the Cross; you only saw a rag<sup>20</sup>, the laughingstock<sup>21</sup> of a people confused by sin and the evil of satan, who seized the hearts and souls of those who governed you<sup>22</sup> in justice and charity; justice and charity of a lost world and doomed to the gates of hell, because it did not see the Light of the Holy Spirit that was before it, that shone as never before on this world, because it had come down from heaven and was before you, children.

Now is the time of love, of mercy, of seeing the Glory on the Cross, of seeing the Son of man covered in Glory and Majesty in the torment and torture of the Cross. You must learn and seek this Glory for yourselves in your lives, but how far you are children, from understanding the Glory of the Cross<sup>23</sup>; you still beg and seek the cheap glory of this world that will be repelled and filled with rust and perch, and so you will present yourself before the Son of God, with that glory in your hands. No children, no, look at Me on the Cross and before you see Me come down with My Glory and Majesty from heaven you must learn to see My Glory on the Cross<sup>24</sup>, in your Savior dead on the Cross for your Salvation. In your every day cross<sup>25</sup> you must see your glory, with which you must present yourselves before Me on the day that I summon you from east to west<sup>26</sup>.

It is not too late to start, I have said this to you before, but if you hold off, you will not have the time because time is running out, children, you live as if the time were to last forever, no, it is over, the favorable time for forgiveness, for the Eucharist and the time of having My holy priests close

to you who will take the sacraments will end. After a time of rigor everything will change and you will not have the favorable time that you still have in your lives today.

Look at Me on the Cross<sup>27</sup> and when you see Me before you that day you will give Glory to He who never lost it but who was obscured before you by your sin and slander.

The light of the Holy Spirit shines in My Cross of ignominy and sin, the Love of the Father extends to you His paternal hands to give you His Son dead on the Cross for you, for your Salvation<sup>28</sup>, to redeem you from sin. It is the Glory of Love, of Charity, of the greatest Love<sup>29</sup>, of the most cruel suffering and pain made Love and Forgiveness for you, children.

Before you see Me come down from heaven you must learn the Glory of the Cross.

O Children of God, children of the Most High, seek in your hearts the silence to live the Love of the Cross<sup>30</sup>, to love the cruel instrument that brought you your Salvation that will give you the Glory of Heaven, the Eternal Glory.

Nothing else I should tell you; follow the path of your Good Shepherd<sup>31</sup>, sheep of My Flock and love the Commandments<sup>32</sup>, live the Gospel and love the Cross, the Glory of the Cross; and one day you will be with Me in Heaven for an Eternity of Love with the Son of man, amen, amen.
