

MESSAGE 102 NOVEMBER.1.2022

«My chariots of fire¹ will come and defeat evil², but until then there will be pain and cries³ on earth, for man has rejected his God⁴ who loves him without ceasing and knocks at the door⁵ of his heart again and again.

It is late, there is no time, time is running out, but man still does not obey the voice of God, turning his back on his God and Lord⁶. The world groans in pain and everything will end, but man continues to feast, turning his back on his Creator in a suicidal and mad attitude. Man is full of pride and fatuity⁷, alienated and insane; he does not want to realize who he is, where he comes from, where he is going; he lives unbridled, without realizing the truth of his existence, the reason for his life, his existence and his final destiny, and this will bring him an endless number of misfortunes.

Listen, My people, and heed My Words, words of love and salvation⁸, in a night that ends and gives way to the new day⁹.

will I stop your race? The precipice awaits you and My arms will remain without you. What will I do¹²? I am the Prince of Love and I am at your door, but your door closes on Me again and again and My heart trembles because I see your doom, your rejection to Love. What shall I do?
