Children, pay attention to the spirit, that you are spiritual and everyone who lives in the spirit will inherit the Spiritual Kingdom, which transcends all appetite and sensuality, which moves away from the mundane. He who lives according to the spirit will inherit a spiritual life<sup>23</sup>, which is not corrupted, which does not end in the ground and corruption.

Courage and do not be afraid. The suffering of the cross when it is redemptive is bravery and courage, love and joy because you are not of this world<sup>28</sup> forever, you are pilgrims<sup>29</sup> your goal is the House of the Father<sup>30</sup> for an Eternity.
