

MESSAGE 92 JANUARY.1.2022

«In the silence of the night¹ the bells announce a new year, a year of goods and grace who you wish one another, but who desires My coming²? May the Son of Man come to rule the Earth with an iron³ rod and a Heart of Mercy⁴.

Oh children how alienated you are, only pending on the things of this world⁵. You greet the new year with drunkenness and ruckus, noise and debauchery⁶, but who receives it with peace and harmony, prayer and supplication to God? Thus your disposition is pleasing to God and you earn treasures in Heaven. Always live everything in God and from God, even if you are immersed in the greatest uproar of this world and you will be pleasing to God⁷.

It is time of conversion because the Lord of lords, the King of kings⁸ comes to this world. He has an appointment in your heart and there you will see not only your life but also the plan of God in it⁹ and you will see if you have been faithful to that plan of Love or have frustrated it in you.

It is time of penance because the Lord of lords and the King of kings comes and what will He find in your hearts¹⁰? The inflicted penance is pleasing to God if it is in a right conscience and upright and safe judgment, but the most pleasing to God is the one that life infringes in you, this world and you accept it with peace and hope in God, offering everything to the

Be cautious in your actions in front of men and keep for the God of Heaven the secret of your heart²¹, where you enclose your love for God as in a tabernacle and He deposits in it all His Grace.

Keep your eyes away from the world and enclose your faith in the interior darkness, illuminated only by the light of the tabernacle of your heart, of your faith²². There it will grow and be strengthened in the inner intimacy and will bear fruit in its season²³ when the Lord comes to harvest the Earth and reap the harvest²⁴. The grape will be trodden in the winepress of your life and your blood will be shed for the Kingdom of Christ²⁵.

May only the light of faith and good works²⁶ shine on you.
