

MESSAGE 93 FEBRUARY.1.2022

«Come and see how good the Lord is, blessed is he who takes refuge in Him¹, there are songs of victory in the tents of the righteous². Come and see how good the Lord is, blessed is he who takes refuge in Him.

In the tents of the righteous dwells the God of Israel, who stands by the Lord will not be disappointed³. Come and see how good the Lord is, blessed is he who sits at the right hand of the Lord⁴. He is at his right hand, at the right hand of the God of Israel⁵, he will not be disappointed.

There are songs of victory in the tents of the righteous⁶, they praise and cheer the God of Israel⁷, One and Triune is the God of Israel⁸, glory, glory to Him⁹.

It is not late for the victory, it is time for joy, because His is the victory¹⁰, sure and certain victory. Glory, glory to Him.

The people of God is a victorious people, because the victory belongs to the King, the King of Israel; His is the Power and the Glory, and His people are a victorious people and must always live in the joy of victory and not in the sadness of defeat.

the victory, people of the Lord, because it is the victory of your King and Lord.

Why do you walk sad and downcast, people of God? Is not your King the God of Israel? Brighten your face¹⁷ and clap your hands, son of God, because your God is the King, and his is the victory, you will not be disappointed.

When you wait for news from the world you find a song of joy and victory, it is the song of the people of God, the victorious people in battle, because God fights for them, assists them in battle.

The people of God must be a happy and confident people in the victory of their God. If you are sad and downcast, to which people do you belong? Joy is the countenance of the Son of God, it is the sign of his faith in the Victorious One, and it is the sign of faith, of his filiality¹⁸ with the Powerful, of his bond with the God of Heaven¹⁹.

What people welcomed God and was disappointed forever? Lift up your spirits, people of Israel, because your God and Lord is with you and assists you in battle, the God of Israel leads the battle.

Come and see how good the Lord is.

You say you have faith and you have no joy. Where is your faith? Only the merry-hearted shows his faith, his faith in the victory of God.

What victorious people is sad? Sadness is typical of defeat. If you are in the ranks of the people of God there is no room for the sadness²⁰ of defeat, but the joy of victory.

It is a song of victory of the people of God. When everything threatens ruin, victory belongs to God; live in the victory of your God and not in defeat; defeat will be for the enemies of God. Even if you died in battle²¹, the battle will lead you to victory and you will not be disappointed forever. He only lives in sadness who does not trust in the victory of God”.

My people, people of God, today I address you, My dear children²², with a song of victory for your hearts. The angels have sung it for you.
