

**MESSAGE 127      DECEMBER.1.2024**

«This night will pass. It is a sign of the love of God, a sign of the Love of and Mercy of God to a rebellious and wayward<sup>1</sup> people who have separated themselves from the Love of God<sup>2</sup>, have separated themselves from His Love and have gone after other gods<sup>3</sup> and after themselves.

There will be a purification as there has never been nor will there be<sup>4</sup>, because of its a wayward and evil people who have transgressed the Law of the Lord, the Mandate of Love contained in His Law and His Mandates<sup>5</sup>, which the Lord left to His people from long ago so that, guided by them, they would reach the fullness of Love<sup>6</sup>.

Therefore, children, tonight I say to you: You must see a sign of the Love and Mercy of God because without this darkness that is going to descend upon this world in these years<sup>7</sup> of purification, no soul would be saved of those who are doomed, at this moment and in the future, to the precipice of perdition and their souls would be consumed in eternal fire<sup>8</sup>; but in this purification, children, that is going to ravage the entire world, these souls destined by their sins and their rebellion to obey My voice will have a unique opportunity for salvation.

It is not time to be carried away by fashions in opinions and spiritual trends, it is time to tighten your belt and sandals<sup>9</sup> and not listen to everything that reaches your ears, in the silence of the Love of God and His Law of Love walk through the desert of your life to meet Me.

I will protect you and be attentive to you in this time like no other, as there has never been nor will there be. Begin to seriously reflect on your life about the time you will live and thus prepare yourselves for everything that, in the Mercy of God, is going to come to you: a time of unparalleled suffering because they will try to confuse you with all kinds of false rants and signs<sup>10</sup>; the only sign is the Cross, and anyone who goes after all that they will offer will perish in it<sup>11</sup>.

I only have to give you a serious warning: I see that you do not take My Words seriously and you continue feasting on the path of your life, you do not prepare<sup>12</sup> yourselves nor do you follow this path open for you and your salvation: that of warning you of a time of rigor<sup>13</sup>, children, which is written for you in the Holy Scripture.

Anyone who turns a deaf ear will perish on the path of perdition<sup>14</sup> that will spread throughout this world and will be deceived and trampled by the fury of Satan, the devil.

All those who believe in their own strength, and do not need My Help<sup>15</sup>, the one that I will send in these unrivaled times of confusion and perdition, will be fooled and trampled by the fury of Satan<sup>16</sup>.

You do not take My Words<sup>17</sup> seriously and I am sending them to you because I see the serious and grave problem and risk in which you are debating and struggling and will be even more so; risk of deception and perdition, falsehood and disbelief in everything holy<sup>18</sup> that, for centuries, has governed the path of the Church and has been a light and guide for her.

That is why I tell you, children, on this night you must arm yourselves with patience in suffering<sup>19</sup> and courage in trials, not allowing yourselves to be deceived by the soft and sweet siren songs that will resonate in your ears wanting to turn you away from the path of the Cross, the only sure path to the Eternal Salvation of your souls.

It is time to arm yourselves with patience and be brave in the ‘yes’ and ‘no’<sup>20</sup> that you must say at every moment; I will help you and alleviate your suffering<sup>21</sup>, but listen to Me and pay attention to My Words carefully.

In a world alienated from the truth that only pursues its own desire and selfishness, I tell you: Times of perdition are coming for your souls such as have never been nor will be because Satan has dominion over a time of trial granted by the Father for the purification of the hearts<sup>22</sup> of His children and your feelings will be seen in the light, and your intentions and desires will remain before the eyes of your God and Lord, and you will deceive no one but yourselves<sup>23</sup> if you want to defend a path that is condemned to perdition for having separated from the Cross of the Lord.

Sin sweeps this world and is condemned by its works and evils. Anyone who lets himself be deceived by this world and its seductions will end badly<sup>24</sup> and will not have the opportunity of the rescue sent by God to the world to save His children<sup>25</sup> from the clutches of the evil one.

The world will try to take you with it to eternal perdition, you have been warned of the dangers time and time again, but I see, children, that you do not pay attention.

The powers of this world will fight alongside evil for the ruin of souls. Everything will be confusion and anarchy. The seduction of the powers of this world over the soul will be so strong that without the special help that God will send to the world in this night of rigor, not a single soul<sup>26</sup> would be saved.

The help of God will be in proportion to your helplessness and poverty, the danger and gravity of your soul. Do not be afraid, children, but take My Words seriously, which I address to you today through My instrument, the one I chose out of Mercy for a world doomed to eternal death.

On this night that will fall relentlessly upon this world, I say to you: Arm yourselves with patience and rigor in your lives. There is no salvation outside of Me<sup>27</sup>; and do not be deceived by the soft and delicious harangues of sin<sup>28</sup> that will contaminate the world, and My Church will succumb to such deception and perdition. Only in this apparent death of My Church<sup>29</sup> will there be a glorious resurrection, but before that you will see My Church crucified and in agony: but the forces of evil will not defeat her<sup>30</sup>, because Christ is the Conqueror<sup>31</sup> of death now and forever and the Thrones and Dominations sing "Glory, Glory to the King"<sup>32</sup>, and Heaven bows down and the praise is like thunder that thunders and resounds in an immense noise and bustle of angels<sup>33</sup> wings, and voices that fill and consume Heaven and Earth with the Power and Majesty of God. While the world will be consumed in the praise of the martyrs and of all those who will not bow down<sup>34</sup> to the dominion of evil and its harangues and seductions.

The praise of the faithful children of God until death<sup>37</sup> will rise to Heaven and fill this world with the perfume<sup>38</sup> and the cloud of incense in the midst of the din of the battle where My faithful children, My little ones, will succumb to the rage and anger of the devil who will crush them with fury for being Mine<sup>39</sup>. Some will escape this fury because I, the Lord, will take them<sup>40</sup>: They are those who follow My Words and prepare for it, they will travel the desert that will separate you from the Promised Land<sup>41</sup>: The Kingdom of Christ<sup>42</sup>; with jubilation in your souls and suffering and hardships in your bodies, but the Column of Smoke<sup>43</sup> and the Fire of My Holy Spirit will take you to a hidden place where you will live in a Kingdom of Peace and Eucharistic Love for Christ, The Lord. While the world will struggle in its last breaths of life and will disappear in them.
