

**MESSAGE 134      JULY.1.2025**

« Listen to this lesson of love with your heart: the Creator<sup>1</sup> is in love with His creature, a true God is in love with the work He created, out of Love, out of Love. He sent<sup>2</sup> His Son to a world that never recognized His Love<sup>3</sup>, “so much Love was not enough,” that He stayed and allowed Himself to be touched by dirty hands, and only remained in the tabernacle day and night; and yet “so much Love was not enough” that He sent His Holy Spirit<sup>4</sup> to defend His Creation, but He was also denied; and “so much Love was not enough” that He chose a poor creature to be His defender, and “so much Love was not enough”. who was also denied; and now He asks you, what to do with so much Love? He gave His Mother to you<sup>5</sup>, He shed His Blood for your love<sup>6</sup>, He stayed on the Cross and did not flee<sup>7</sup>, nor did legions of angels come down to help such a Great Lord, the King<sup>8</sup> of kings, and not a vassal remained<sup>9</sup>, a beloved disciple<sup>10</sup> remained, clinging to the Cross of his Lord; His Mother<sup>11</sup>, anguished<sup>12</sup>, left Him to die so that He could fulfill the Will of God<sup>13</sup>. But when will it be enough so much Love? Your heart was left at the door<sup>14</sup>, and “so much Love is not enough.” He gave you forgiveness again and again, and without counting, always, but "so much Love is not enough." And tired of searching for you, one day he sat down, by the side of the road

he stayed, and saw someone pass by, poor and helpless, and he sat down beside Him, not recognizing such a Great Lord<sup>15</sup>; his life told him and what was his surprise that he already knew his pain, his heart was moved and he began to know such a Great Lord who sat by his side and listened to his heart<sup>16</sup>. One day he said it, and many more wanted to seek the Lord<sup>17</sup> who sat by the side of the road, because a poor and helpless man was telling a love story. Now they know more about the Great Lord through the mouth of a homeless man whose life was saved from loneliness and pain, because he listened to his heart and understood it; he gave it His Love, and this Love healed it. Although He is a Great Lord, He needed help to make His Love known, and He made use of a poor and helpless man, because with love He sat by his side, seeking companionship and understanding.

This Great Lord sits by the side of the road and knows that you will pass by him, but not everyone stands before him and sits by his side, opening their hearts; only a poor and helpless person was and is the one who sees and wants to know such a Great Lord. His tunic touched the ground, His sandals revealed His feet, His hands were in the light of day; He could be seen. For the poor and helpless man, so much Love was enough. Now he follows him wherever he goes and from time to time he sees him sitting by the side of the road, and there he sits again to open his heart and ask him, "How are you?"

Nothing is enough for those who do not sit at His side and close to Him. Only like this, only like this.

Now I tell you, my son, as you read these Words: What shall I do with you? How shall I discover your love for the Savior if you do not stand by My side and want to be with Me? It is in your heart; God placed it there, but you cannot find it, nor do you know it is there.

If you see me on the road, come closer and we will talk. You will tell me and I will listen, and in the end I will give you My Blessing. Your sins are on My Cross, where I paid<sup>22</sup> for them; with My Blood they are forgotten if you are repentant in your heart. My Heart seeks you and never ceases to seek you.

The world does not know Me, but it will know Me. I will send a poor and helpless person who found Me on the side of the road and stayed by My side. Her name is Isabel, and she knows My Love. She will tell you, and you will listen, because you need My Love.

Do not delay, it is late and there is no time. Come, before I am no longer at the side of the road<sup>23</sup>.»
