2026, FOR “WEDNESDAYS”**

Lent and the Passion of Our Glorious Supreme Shepherd.

Having been called by the grace of God to be part of the work of the Supreme Shepherd, our commitment is to remain listening to His voice, walk in holiness of life, fulfilling His Words and the invitations of His Merciful Heart, which lovingly invites us to be among His sheep who listen attentively and fulfill His Divine Designs.

Lent is a time of grace and blessing that begins with Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026; it is the 40-day liturgical season of preparation, fasting, and reflection in the Catholic Church to live the Paschal Mystery.

This period prepares us to experience the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, culminating in Holy Week.

Lent is a time of preparation that represents Jesus' 40 days in the desert, his conversion, and a time for reflection to cleanse the soul, using the color purple.

Practices of this holy time: It focuses on prayer, fasting and almsgiving (charity) to renew faith.

Duration: It begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes before the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, giving way to the Easter Triduum.

The Passion of Christ: The Paschal Mystery.

Definition: The "Passion" encompasses the physical and spiritual sufferings of Jesus Our Supreme Shepherd, including His trial, torture, and crucifixion.

Key moments are:

Palm Sunday: Triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem.

Holy Thursday: Institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood.

Good Friday: Commemorates the crucifixion and death of Christ, our glorious Supreme Shepherd, being the most solemn day.

Spiritual Meaning: It is seen as the greatest act of God's love and merciful surrender; it is inviting us to conversion and to unite our sufferings to those of Christ in a victimization of love and surrender.

This period invites us to experience faith more deeply, accompanying Jesus the Suffering Shepherd on the Way of the Cross, and moves us to reflect on the offering of His life.

To experience these saving events, Our Blessed Supreme Shepherd asks us to meditate again and contemplate with singular love the visions He has left us, His Messages of mercy through His instrument Isabel of God, especially the visions received and published from October 24, 2018 to October 21, 2020 about the Passion of Our adorable Supreme Shepherd.

Especially every Wednesday, in deep prayer, we celebrate with our hearts the Messages of the redemptive work of our Glorious Shepherd who continues to give His life on the altar of the Cross for the rescue of so many sinners who are eternally lost every day.

I invite all those called to live in the Work of the Supreme Shepherd to meditate on His Messages, especially the visions, with a missionary spirit, asking with all their heart for the conversion of all sinners in accordance with the desires of the Merciful Eucharistic Heart of Our Glorious Supreme Shepherd, who does not want a single one of His redeemed by His most precious Blood to be lost.

Let all members of this Work of holiness live united in prayer and meditation, especially every Wednesday. May this beginning of Lent be filled with great blessings for the Work. May God bless and strengthen His instrument Isabel and encourage her to continue embracing with love the Glorious Cross of Our Blessed Supreme Shepherd. Amen
